2620 18th Avenue – William and Louise Hollis House

The circa 1885 house was the residence of William and Louise Hollis. Hollis was a prominent attorney and judge during the early 1900s, a prominent member of the Freemasons, and a director of the First National Bank of Oregon.

The 1 and ½ story Hollis House is a fine example of the vernacular adaptation of the Stick Style. The house features a cross gable roof, wood gable end ornamentation, decorative scrollwork on the window bay and original tall narrow wood windows.
