2019 21st Avenue – Pacific University – Old Rogers City Library

The former Rogers City Library building is one story high and three bays wide with a flat roof and stucco siding over the brick wall construction. The building is named for Mrs. Adeline Rogers who donated the land and the building to the City of Forest Grove in 1909. The building was later known as the Rogers Free Library and this city promised to maintain the free reading room and rest room every day except Sunday. This was the first city library of Forest Grove.
