### 2043 College Way – Pacific University – Marsh Hall

Marsh Hall was constructed in 1895 by notable Portland architects Whidden and Lewis. They also designed the Carnegie Library Building on the Pacific University Campus. Marsh Hall is named for Dr. Sidney Harper Marsh, the first president of the University. Marsh Hall is a 2 and ½ story Jacobethan Style Building with steeply pitched gable roof clad with copper sheathing. The building features brick construction with stone details surrounding the door and window openings. The arched main entry features double front doors with sidelights and transom. There is a 1 and ½ story brick tower that is capped with rock faced stone.
