2209 College Way – Pacific University – McCormick Hall

McCormick Hall is the only Craftsman Style institutional building in Forest Grove and was built by Al Redetske and Levi Sparks in 1924. The 2 and ½ story McCormick Hall was built as a men's dormitory. The building features shed roof dormers, brick siding and 6-over-1 double hung sash windows. The building has four two-story porches with wooden railing and columns. The main entrance on the south façade features a two story portico and a double entry door with sidelights and transom. The second story of the porch is supported by large brick piers and enclosed by a wooden railing. An addition was constructed in 1947 that replicated the style and materials of the original building, including brick from the local source of the original brick.
