

Forest Grove Historic Resource



Pacific University – Warner Hall

Warner Hall was moved from Camp Adair after World War II and the exterior was bricked over during the renovation to make it suitable for the University's use. It is thought to have been the Enlisted Mens' Club Building at Camp Adair (Tabitha Hall is also a relocated Camp Adair Building). The building was dismantled after World War II and then reassembled in Forest Grove. Part of the building contains a theater for student production.

Warner Hall is a two-story building that features a symmetrical plan, brick veneer and eight-over-eight double-hung wood sash windows.
