


Our water moves in one big cycle. Help keep it clean.

Here at Clean Water Services, we want you to know we appreciate everything you do to help us keep your water clean. Your support of our efforts is greatly valued. And because we know you are vital to our success, we'll leave you with some simple clean water tips and rate information.



### Cut the Chemicals.

When it rains, fertilizers and pesticides can get washed into drains. So use fewer chemicals and leave grass clippings on the lawn.



### Do the Doody.

Dog doo that's left on the ground runs into drains and makes our water dirty. So grab a bag before your next walk and tell a friend to do the same.

### Can the Wipes.

Wipes, rags and towelettes that are flushed down the toilet lead to clogged pipes, sewer backups and expensive repairs. So make sure you throw all cleaning materials in the trash.



#### New rates take effect July 1, 2010

Clean Water Services' **sanitary sewer rate is proposed to increase 5.5 percent or about \$1.80 a month** for the average household. Clean Water Services' **Surface Water Management fee is proposed to increase 11.76 percent or \$0.50 per month** for the average household. These proposed increases will take effect July 1, 2010 and will be shared proportionately between Clean Water Services and its member cities. The increases are necessary to meet stringent federal water quality requirements; pay for rising power and chemical costs; fund flood management and water quality projects; and to upgrade and maintain the community's wastewater collection and treatment facilities. **To learn more, visit [www.cleanwaterservices.org/rates](http://www.cleanwaterservices.org/rates).**
