3 SINGLE ITEMS PER CUSTOMER.

Couches, mattresses, appliances, etc. Appliances must have refrigerant removed per DEQ regulations.



Prohibited materials include all hazardous waste materials; all construction, remodeling, or demolition materials; all kitchen garbage, residential yard debris and trimmings, and waste and recyclables collected curbside.

4 TIRES PER CUSTOMER.

No charge for 3 items or tires.

Mixed loads of construction, remodeling debris or other waste will be charged according to fee schedule.

Reminder: E-Waste (televisions, computers, monitors) are accepted at all times for recycling.



Proof of residency will be required.






