

You may be wondering why the FYI Forest Grove inserts with your utility bill includes events that have been canceled. By way of explanation, the inserts were finalized and printed the last week of February prior to any issues surrounding the COVID-19 situation. The utility bills are sent out to a different section of the City each week so it takes a month to complete the cycle of billing including the inserts.

While most April events have been cancelled, there is still relevant information in the inserts. Such as, applications are still being taken for the City Council position and the Community Enhancement Program and entries for the "If I Were Mayor" Student Contest and the Historic Photo Contest are still being accepted.

Earth Day Fair & Litter Clean Up, April 18, POSTPONED to later date

Tree City USA Annual Tree Planting, April 24, POSTPONED to later date in Fall

Annual Prescription Drug Take Back, April 25, CANCELED

Children's Day, April 29, CANCELED

Spring City-Wide Clean Up, usually in May, POSTPONED to June 22 – 27.
