Learn how to protect your community from scammers, schemers, swindlers, and fraudsters at the Forest Grove Police Department's free educational workshops, designed to teach individuals and groups how to identify and respond to scams.

These free 1—1.5 hour session can be tailored to the needs of your community group. Topics include overviews of common scam calls, emails, and letters, basic prevention and security measures, Q&A, and fraud prevention resources.

SCAM WORKSHOP—WHAT IS IT?

In light of the recent waves of telephone, internet, and mail scams, the Forest Grove Police Department is working hard to protect all citizens from fraudulent crimes, including identity theft, Internet and email swindles, and phone scams.

Our new Scam Education Program is a free seminar and workshop designed for community groups to learn the tools to successfully identify and respond to common scams. Activities include overviews of types of scams, tips for identifying and protecting against fraudulent letters, emails and calls, what to do if you think you've been scammed, as well as role-playing, an extensive Q& A time, plus literature regarding fraud protection. Seminars are led by the FGPD Community Outreach Specialist.



WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Workshops are open to any local community groups, civic clubs, religious organizations, assisted living facilities, neighborhood watch programs, HOAs and apartment complexes, and any other community group. We ask that groups have at least ten adults in attendance.
